Our MDSA's are responsible for the welfare and safety of our children during the lunchtime whilst they eat their lunch in the dining room and during playtime. Duties also include administering basic first aid. The ideal candidate will enjoy working with children, be a good role model for our children and show initiative by supporting positive relationships and play opportunities during the lunchtime. The contract is for 1.25 hours per day Monday to Friday and paid at Grade 2 pt. 3 (£24,796) pa pro rata term time only and is fixed term from 1st September 2026 to 31st August 2027. The hours will be between 11.30 a.m. and 1.30 p.m. as confirmed upon appointment.
