We will learn about the qualities of a good friend and how to be a safe pedestrian. We will be developing our skills when working in a team through playing lots of different games.



Communication and Language

We will use minibeast themed books to inspire our storytelling and use activities linked to the stories to develop our language and speaking and listening skills.

Physical Development

In P.E. we will use a range of equipment to develop our throwing, catching and rolling skills. We will also develop our fine motor skills with activities, such as minibeast cutting and spider web threading.



Literacy

We will be using our phonic knowledge to write about minibeasts and their lifecycles. We will also research and write some fun facts about insects.

Maths

We will practise and consolidate our learning of subitising, counting, composition and comparing numbers. We will begin to explore numbers above ten and will solve problems involving adding more and taking away.



Expressive Art and Design

We will be designing and combining media to make our own minibeasts. We will use the laptops to create a minibeast garden. We will be moving to music with instruction, changing movements to match the tempo, pitch or dynamic of the piece. We will look at the artwork of Henri Matisse and create our own abstract artwork.

Understanding the World

We will learn about the lifecycle of a butterfly through caring for real caterpillars. We will also learn lots of interesting facts about worms and about different habitats.
