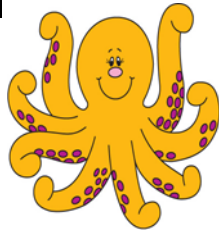


Communication and Language

We will use under the sea themed books to introduce new language and extend vocabulary. We will be responding to what we hear with relevant comments and giving reasons for our thoughts and ideas during class debates.

Physical Development

In P.E. we will continue to use a range of equipment to develop our throwing, catching and kicking skills. We will also develop our fine motor skills with activities such as making different sea creatures and shell fossils.



Literacy

We will be responding to the stories we read, summarising key events in a story map and using these ideas to create and write our own stories. We will also think of, and write some fun facts about sea creatures.



Maths

We will continue to explore how quantities can be changed by adding more and taking away objects, creating mathematical stories. We will learn that 'double' means twice as many. We will explore how to share and group objects as an early introduction to division.



Expressive Art and Design

We will be creating an under the sea colour wash by mixing different shades of blue and green. We will be developing our imagination by learning how to visualise and describe a range of objects and scenes.

Understanding the World

We will explore different sea creatures and their features. We will design and make boats using a range of materials and test our boats to see if they float or sink.
