Use paragraphs to organise your writing (remembering to start on a new line and indent).

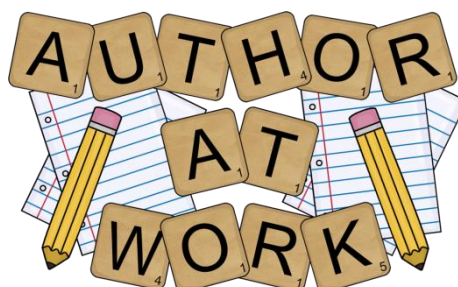
Use apostrophes for contraction and possession.
