Statement of Accounts by Gemma Standen - Presented at the AGM 15 June 2022

The income generated for the financial year 2021/2022 was £12,299.26 which is a fantastic achievement for the year and for the school year to date is £13,901.93 and again is a massive achievement for all of those involved in the committee.

A massive thank you to all the parents that have contributed over this year and a great achievement as this has doubled last year's figures. The money raised was from events like the Summer Faye, Easter egg hunt, Fireworks night, Discos, Uniform sales and Christmas card sales.

These figures include donations from 2 companies totalling £4,884.00. We have definitely seen a massive difference in the total raised over this year and has mainly due to the fact that the previous couple of years as the pandemic restrictions have eased and lifted we have been unable to put on fundraising events. From the funds raised this academic year some of the bids that we have granted and paid for are as follows:

- A Donation of £5,000 for up and coming project
- Jubilee tree
- SAT's breakfast
- Storage for reception/ year 1
- Tidy up and safety for Reception playground
- Key Stage 1 books from Santa
- Wet pay suits for Key stage 1
- More storage for Junior site for the library

The PTA bank account as of today 15th June 2022 holds £6,176.75 however, the invoice for the junior library £2889 (yet to be received), along with the storage for reception (invoice yet to be

received) and the plaque for the jubilee tree (yet to be purchased approx £50.00) is still to be deducted. Therefore the balance would be approx £13,107.

We are still raising funds through uniform sales and have the upcoming Summer Fayre before the end of term.

The committee have done a great job in raising funds this year and appreciate the engagement of

The parents/guardians of the school helping raise and support the PTA in raising funds for the enhancement of the school for the children.
