

## Money

- Use different coins to pay for items in shops
- Talk about how to spend pocket money or gifts of money.
- Work out the change when shopping
- Work out the cost of a certain amount of items
- Work out which product would be cheaper
- Talk about offers/value for money

## Reasoning

- Which would you rather...?
- Prove your ideas
- What maths can you see in this object (eg a packet of biscuits)?

## Play games and sports

- Snakes & ladders
- Connect 4
- Hopscotch
- Score points and goals



# Supporting your child with maths at home: KS2

## Time

- Ask questions: How long will it be in ... minutes?
- Use time as everyday language – bedtimes, dinner time, time for clubs
- Talk about how long it will take to complete an activity.
- Use different clocks eg digital, 24-hour, analogue

## Use positional language

- Use language such as in front of, behind, next to, over, under and in between
- Describe the position of items in relation to others

## Times tables

- Chant tables on the way to school
- Play online games (see school website)
- Sing songs
- Quick fire questions
- Homemade flash cards

## Cooking

- Weigh ingredients
- Discuss temperatures
