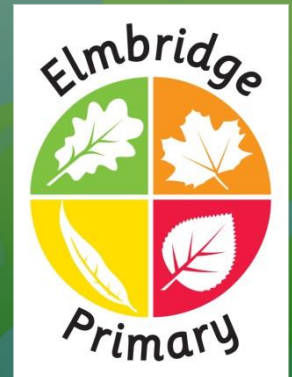

Preparation for entering KS2

- Visits throughout the year
- Assemblies – including whole school
- Year 3 Staff visit Year 2 children and talk to their teachers

Uniform

- PE kit in school at all times - red t-shirt and black shorts with trainers (no jewellery)
- School shoes not trainers (except playtimes)
- No jewellery other than stud earrings and watches
- Hair longer than shoulders needs to be tied back
- All uniform **MUST** be clearly named

Food

- A Healthy School
- Named water bottles with sports tops in class
- Fruit or vegetable snack – in KS2 the government does not provide free fruit for children
- School meals cooked on site – in KS2 school meals are no longer free. They cost £2.32 a day.
- Your child may be able to have Free School Meals(FSM) if you are in receipt of certain benefits. You will need to apply for FSM via 01452 425390 or www.gloucestershire.gov.uk/freeschoolmeals
- School meals to be paid for in advance via the internet
- Choice of menu

First Day

- School starts at **8.50am** when a bell will be rung
- On the first day the children will line up on Lower School Playground in classes
- Staff will collect the children from the playground
- Lunches – no need to pay for hot dinners on the first day, you will be charged for them when ‘Parentpay’ is set up
- School ends at **3.10pm**. If your child is attending after school club we will escort them there
